William Wade "Bill" Dudley, 68, of Perryton died June 5, 2014. Funeral services were held Tuesday, June 10, at 2 p.m. at First United Methodist Church with Rev. Mark Metzger officiating. Burial was in Ochiltree Cemetery under the direction of Boxwell Brothers Funeral Home. He was born Oct. 2, 1945 in Flint, MI, and lived all over the world and in the United States while his father served as a lieutenant colonel in the United States Air Force. He graduated from Alamogordo (NM) High School, and joined the New Mexico National Guard. After his service, he attended New Mexico State University in Las Cruces, graduating in 1972 with a bachelor of business administration and a bachelor's degree in accounting. He worked in Houston for several years, including serving as finance manager for Mustang Tractor and Equipment and later as controller for Port-A-Kamp Manufacturing. He married Mary Hudson on Feb. 14, 1981 in Perryton, and they lived in Houston. They moved to Perryton in 1984, where he was manager of Perryton Office Supply-Radio Shack from 1984-1996. He joined Perry Equity in 1996, retiring as controller in 2011. He was a member of First United Methodist Church, a former member of the Perryton Rotary Club and had served as treasurer of the Perryton-Ochiltree Chamber of Commerce board. He was preceded in death by his parent, John W. and Phyllis Dudley. He is survived by his wife, Mary, of Perryton, two sons, Chris Dudley of Equatorial Guinea, Africa and girlfriend Emily Parten of Perryton, and Will Dudley of Fort Hood; one daughter and her husband, Lindsay and Brad Marsh of Cypress; his sister, Martha Wilson of Mesa, AZ; two granddaughters, Ava and Georgia Marsh; and his mother-in-law, Jane Hudson of Perryton.
