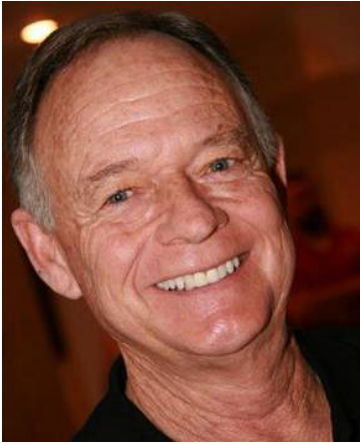


Dennis Martin Posey, 68
